c) Purposes and legal bases of data processing

We process your personal data for the purpose of fulfilling a contract. The legal basis for this is Article 6 (1) lit. b) DSGVO.

d) Recipients or categories of recipients of your personal data

Your personal data will be provided by the company's internal offices at the MRU GmbH Involved in the business transaction. These are the sales and accounting departments.

e) Transfer of your personal data to a third country

We do not plan to transfer your personal data to a third country or an international organization.

f) Duration of storage of your personal data

The data stored by us will be deleted as soon as they are no longer necessary for their purpose and the deletion does not conflict with any legal retention obligations. According to legal requirements, the storage is for 6 years pursuant to § 257 para. 1 HGB (Trading books, inventories, opening balance sheets, annual accounts, trade letters, accounting documents, etc.) and for 10 years pursuant to § 147 para 1 AO (books, records, management reports, Accounting documents, trade and business letters, documents relevant for taxation, etc..

g) Your rights as an affected person

You have the right at any time to obtain free information on the data stored concerning your person (art. 15 DSGVO) as well as rectification (art. 16 DSGVO), deletion (art. 17 DSGVO), limitation of processing (art. 18 DSGVO) and data transferability (Art. 20 DSGVO).

h) Right to object

You may at any time object to the future processing of your personal data in accordance with the legal requirements. The opposition may be in particular against processing for direct marketing purposes

i) Right of complaint

You can complain to the responsible supervisory authority about unauthorized data processing.

j) Provision of personal data

The personal data provided by you are required for the fulfillment of our contractual relationship.

k) Automated decision-making

We do not use automated decision-making.
